I, Anja Bargmann, resident in Am Sandberg 11, 29614 Soltau, have closely observed the development of the MoseMinistries Project under the leadership of Pastor Gideon Jacob, whom I first met in Germany. In the years 2008 and 2010 first 10, and then 8 girls came to Germany and Poland as part of a tour. They took part in a few public cultural events and were of great benefit to these events, as they performed classical Indian dances and music, and told of their daily lives in India.

The people in Europe are very interested in Indian culture and very much enjoyed the Indian music, the dancing and the costumes. The purpose of the performances, was to demonstrate and exchange ideas and culture. At no time did the girls receive any money for these performances and they did not at any time beg for money for their dancing or music. They were not exploited and abused in any way. Furthermore, these events took place under the care and appropriate supervision of their Indian supervisory personnel. I myself was present at all these events, and involved in the organisation and coordination of the trip and the performances. I hereby confirm that the girls were appropriately supervised, accompanied and adequately protected at all times.

I also had the great opportunity to visit these girls in their home in India and to understand how much they feel home in MoseMinistries and with their stuff of co-workers who protect them in a very reflected manner.
